### ABOUT XCEL ENERGY

Xcel Energy is a U.S. investor-owned electricity and natural gas company with regulated operations in eight Midwestern and Western states. We serve 3.4 million electricity customers and 1.9 million natural gas customers through four wholly owned utility subsidiaries. Public Service Company of Colorado serves electric customers of Colorado.

In 2009, the American Wind Energy Association named Xcel Energy the investor-owned utility of the year for its national leadership and **six-year ranking as the No. 1 wind energy provider**. Xcel Energy is ranked **fifth in the nation in total solar capacity** by the Solar Electric Power Association.

We are a founding reporter of The Climate Registry, a nonprofit organization established to measure and publicly report greenhouse gas emissions. For the second year, Xcel Energy is listed on the Carbon Disclosure Project's **leadership index for the quality of our voluntary carbon disclosure**.

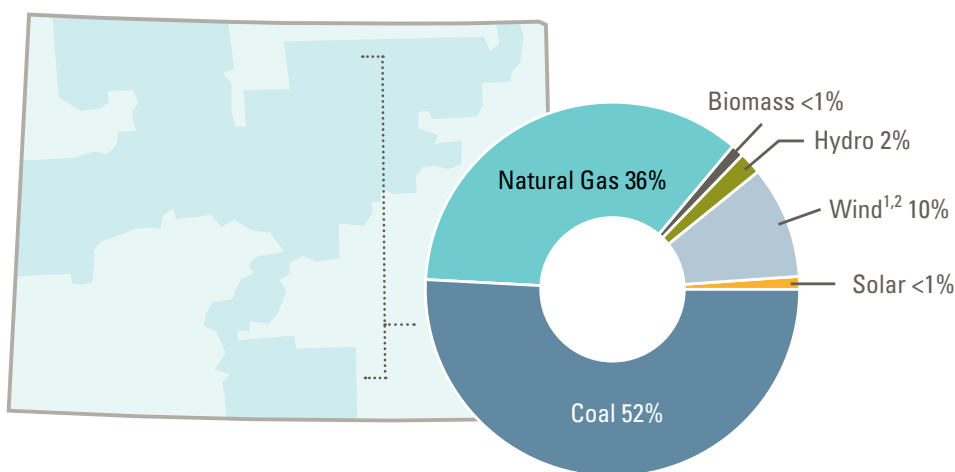

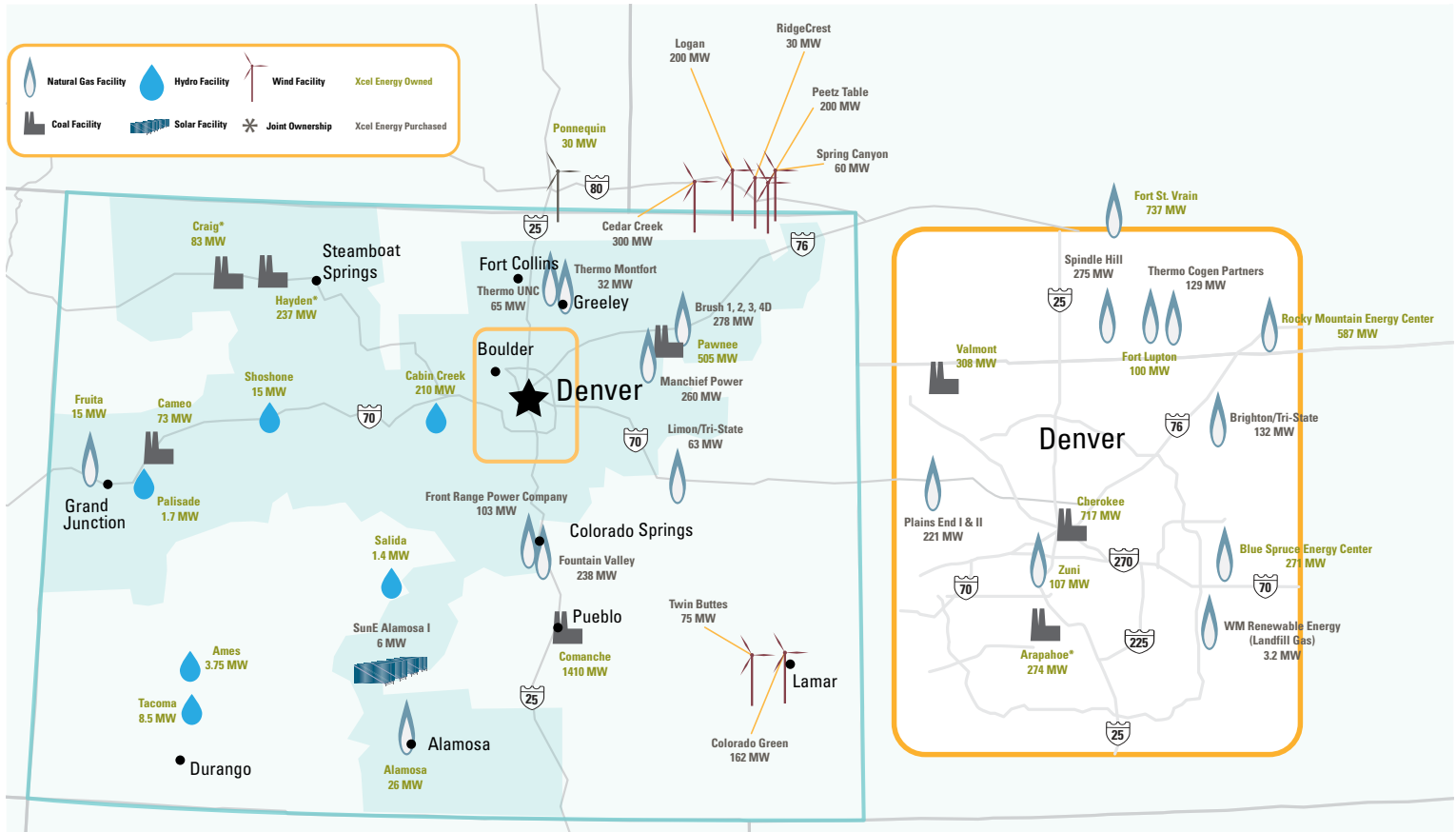

**2009 COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

Colorado Area Grants in environment, education, economic sustainability and arts and culture totalled \$1,047,500. An additional \$991,842 was given through special employee monetary matches for giving and volunteering, including to the United Way – **for a total of \$2,039,342** in charitable giving throughout Xcel Energy’s Colorado territory.
